The Wyoming Space Grant is seeking a diverse team of enthusiastic undergraduate students to participate in the upcoming Nationwide Eclipse Ballooning Project. This team will travel to both the October 2023 annular solar eclipse and April 2024 total solar eclipse to fly weather balloons and collect meteorological observations. Apply today to be a part of this unique opportunity!

WHO IS ELIGIBLE

- Open to undergraduate students from all majors and academic backgrounds!
- Students must be enrolled full-time at UW or LCCC through at least May 2024
- Ideal participants are **responsible, committed students** with a genuine interest in the project and ability to work as part of a team
- Women and students from underrepresented groups are encouraged to apply

PROJECT DETAILS

The project will run from **January 2023 through May 2024**. Participants will receive a monetary stipend for their time participating in various hands-on phases of the project. All project-related costs and travel expenses will be covered. To be considered, **applicants must be able to commit for the full duration of the project**. This includes participation in both the 2023 and 2024 solar eclipse campaigns. Other conditions also apply (see application page).
